Thank you for your email of 9th May 2015 requesting the following further information:

the contract award notice "2015/S 019-031191" found on Tenders Electronic Daily (<http://ted.europa.eu/udl?uri=TED:NOTICE:031191-2015:TEXT:EN:HTML>) for "Training Simulators" to Krauss-Maffei Wegmann lists a total final value of 111 111 111 111,11 EUR (i.e. 111 billion Euros) while also listing a value of 10 000 000 EUR (ie. 10 million Euros). The contract award notice lists Mrs Rachael Minty as a contact in your ministry.

Please provide me with the following information:

- any documents that state the correct total final value of the contract
- any documents relating to why and/or how the discrepancy seen in the contract award notice came about.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. Section 21 has been applied to the information, it is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest.

Under Section 21 (Information Reasonably Assessible to the Applicant by Other Means) I can confirm that a revised contract award notice was submitted on 19th May 2015 to <http://www.contracts.mod.uk/uk-mod-contracts/>. This notice amended the total final value of the contract to 10M Euros. I can confirm that the figure of 111B Euros was entered incorrectly.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal
