2013 Standard Civil Contract in the Family, Immigration and Asylum, Housing and Debt (“the Contract”) Categories of Law: Notice of Extension of the Contract Period

I write further to the “Headline Intentions for alignment of civil face to face contracts in 2018” document which was published on the Legal Aid Agency’s (“LAA”) website in November 2015.

Your Contract was due to expire on 31 March 2016. In accordance with Clause 2.3 of your Contract for Signature the LAA hereby serves you notice of an extension to the Contract Period by an additional two years. Accordingly, the LAA now requires you to continue to provide Contract Work upon the same terms and conditions as detailed within your Contract **until 23:59:59 on 31 March 2018**.

You do not need to take any further action for this extension to take effect.
