**THE NEW HOMES BONUS SCHEME GRANT DETERMINATION (2016/17)
31/2795**

The Minister of State for Housing and Planning (“the Minister”) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003 hereby makes the following determination:-

Citation

- 1) This determination may be cited as the New Homes Bonus Scheme Grant Determination (2016/17)

Purpose of the grant

- 2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

- 3) The Minister determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in the Annex to this determination.
- 4) The grant will be paid in four quarterly instalments.

Treasury consent

- 6) Before making this determination, the Minister obtained the consent of the Treasury.
