Moulsford Railway Bridge, between Cleeve and Benson Locks

March to July 2015

Moulsford Railway Bridge repair works

Contractors are working on behalf of National Rail to carry out repair and maintenance works to Moulsford Railway Bridge from March to July 2015.

There are two navigable arches at Moulsford Railway Bridge. One bridge arch will be closed at a time. The closed arch will be signalled with a red disc and yellow buoys in front of the arch. There will be floating pontoons underneath the arch that is being worked on. The other bridge arch will remain open to navigation. A safety boat will be present at all times during working periods and will direct river traffic through the bridge and works area if required.

Please follow directional signage, follow any directions given by the safety boat and/or officers of the Environment Agency and navigate slowly and with caution in the area of these works.

River users are reminded that **boats going upstream must give way to boats coming downstream.**
