Impact Assessment

As required under section 9 of the Academies Act 2010, we have carried out an assessment on the likely impact of opening the free school on other local schools. This is based on the maximum distance the majority of pupils travel to school in Woking. Impact takes into account proximity, type of school, achievement, surplus places and basic need. We judge that Hoe Valley School will have a minimal impact on 10 schools and colleges and a moderate impact on the remaining two within the catchment area. In view of the predicted increase in demand for year 7 school places in the period to 2018/19 the free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of any neighbouring schools.
