Your email dated 19th March 2015 is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You requested the following information:

I am working for a research consultancy, Credo Analytics, and am currently researching contracts obtained by the company Integral.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I seek information about The MoD's contracts with Integral (<http://www.integral.co.uk/>) and its subsidiaries that are ongoing or ended on or after 2009.

I would be grateful if you could please confirm the total value, start date and duration of the relevant contracts

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) holds some information relevant to your request. The MOD has not entered into any direct contracts with Integral UK Ltd, either in, or since 2009.

A search of the corporate structure of Integral UK Ltd, however, identified it as a subsidiary of Integral UK Holdings Ltd. Although the MOD has not entered into any direct contracts with Integral UK Holdings Ltd either, we did identify four closed contracts with another subsidiary company SFS Fire Services Ltd. The details of these contracts are provided in the table below:

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
