Delivered on 2014 survey

- Improve our response rate
- Increase awareness of our actions
- Increase confidence to raise issues with GCA
- Increase perception among suppliers of retailers complying with the Code

Acting on 2015 survey

Next steps:

Build supplier confidence

- Tackle the 1 in 5 who say they will not raise issue with GCA
- Encourage more suppliers to undertake training
- Supplier and trade association seminars

Maintain momentum on issues

- Special supplier and expert workshops to progress key issues
- Relentless focus on culture change and compliance

Working Together, Making A Difference Progressing Top 5 Issues

Consumer complaints: review

- Charges and approaches reviewed
- Conclude that retailers appear compliant and charges reasonable
- Findings:
 - Charges range from £0-£45
 - Up to 97% of complaints resolved in-store
 - In-store resolution cheaper
 - Does not appear to be a profit centre

Consumer complaints: conclusion

- GCA proposed best practice:
 - Ensure suppliers understand basis of any complaint charges
 - Provide detailed information about complaints within 5 working days to allow swift supplier action
 - Resolve more complaints in-store to keep costs down

Retailers have supported this approach

Progressing the key issues

Deep dive into forecasting and packaging & design issues

Supplier packaging & design workshop

29 September

- Consider next issue to introduce to Top 5
- Encourage suppliers to monitor and report performance on closed issues

Forensics Drop & drive complaints

Further evidence on these may lead to an investigation

Wider issues

- Working with CMA on supply agreements
- Informing government policy on
 - Prompt payment
 - Food and farming strategy
 - Small Business Conciliation Service
