Radcot Bridge, between Radcot and Grafton Locks

Monday 9 November 2015 for approximately 4 weeks

Radcot Bridge repair works

Oxfordshire County Council is making repairs to Radcot Bridge following the damage that was caused in August when a lorry collided with the parapet. Local contractors will be working on behalf of the council. The works will involve a scaffold structure that will be arranged around the bridge arch. The arch will remain open to navigation with a small reduction in height of 750mm and no reduction in width.

The scaffolding will be installed from Monday 9 November 2015 and the works should be completed by Monday 7 December 2015.

Please follow directional signage, follow any directions given by the contractors and/or officers of the Environment Agency and navigate slowly and with caution in the area of these works.

River users are reminded that **boats going upstream must give way to boats coming downstream.**
