Addition of Public Footpath I118 Bridge Street to Proctor's Park Road,
Barrow upon Soar
Definitive Map Modification Order 2014

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 16 November 2016.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at **Sparkenhoe Committee Room, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RA** on **Tuesday 25 April 2017** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding footpath I118 which extends from a point situated at a junction with Bridge Street at Grid Reference 45733 31730 in a generally south-south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 20 metres to Grid Reference 45732 31728 then continuing in generally westerly and south-westerly directions for a further distance of approximately 35 metres to Proctor's Park Road at Grid Reference 45730 31727 as shown on the Order Map.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 11 January 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 22 February 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 28 March 2017]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case and proofs of evidence are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2014

This Order is made by Leicestershire County Council (hereinafter called "the authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (hereinafter called "the Act"), because it appears to the Leicestershire County Council (hereinafter called "the surveying authority") that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Leicestershire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery by the surveying authority of evidence which (when considered with all relevant evidence available to the surveying authority) shows that a right of way of footpath subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist on land between Bridge Street and Proctor's Park Road, Barrow upon Soar shown by a broken black line with short intervals on Plan No. M711A(P)-01 annexed hereto and described in the Schedule hereto.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Authority hereby order that:-

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 15th May 2014.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Leicestershire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Leicestershire County Council (Addition of Public Footpath I118 Bridge Street to Proctor's Park Road, Barrow upon Soar) Definitive Map Modification Order 2014."

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of path or way to be added

A footpath within the Parish of Barrow upon Soar and the Borough of Charnwood shown by a broken black line with short intervals on Plan No. M711A(P)-01 which extends from a point marked 'A' on the plan situated at a junction with Bridge Street at Grid Reference 45733 31730 in a generally south-south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 20 metres to a point marked 'B' situated at Grid Reference 45732 31728 then continuing in generally westerly and south-westerly directions for a further distance of approximately 35 metres to a point marked 'C' on the plan situated at a junction with Proctor's Park Road at Grid Reference 45730 31727.

Footpath has a width of 2 metres between points 'A' and 'B' on Plan No. M711A(P)-01

Footpath has a width varying between 1.4 and 1.9 metres between the enclosed boundaries between the points marked 'B' and 'C' on Plan No. M711A(P)-01 according to the width of the route.

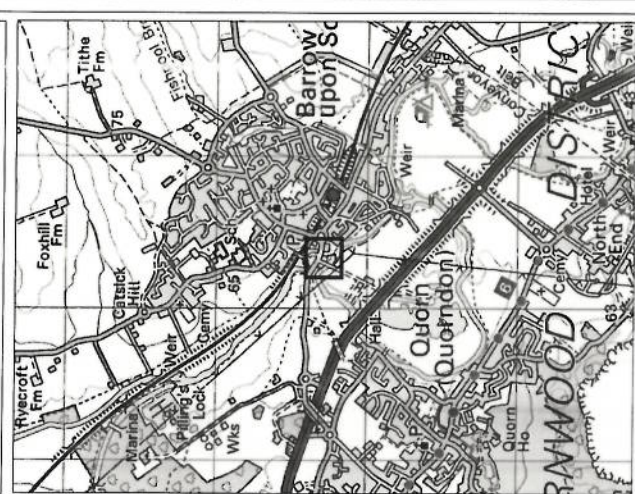

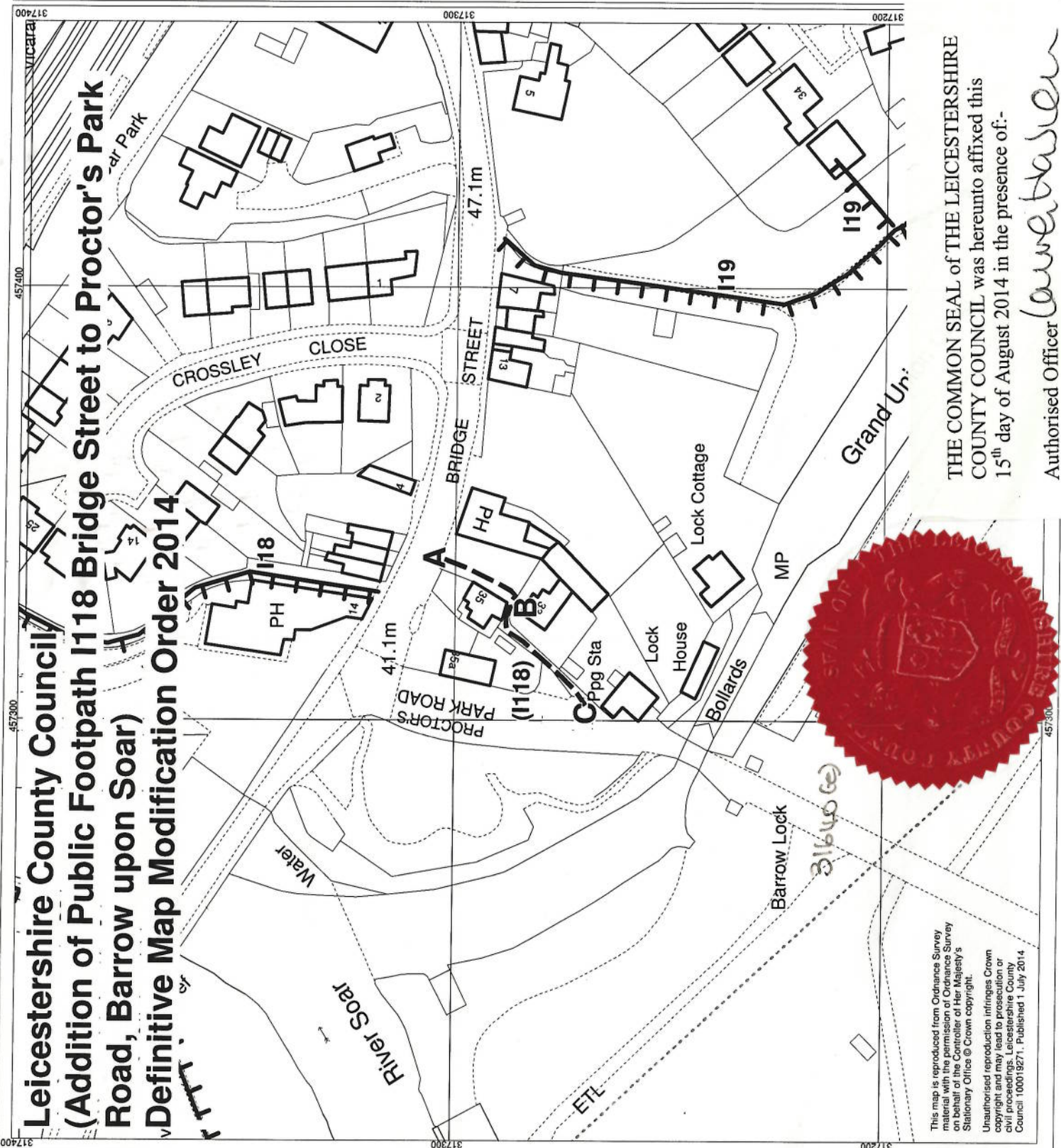
