I refer to your email dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2016.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of the 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2016 you requested the following information:

"1) Please provide details of the total number of days that (a) officers and (b) civilian staff were absent due to sickness in each year since 2013-14, including the year to date. Please also provide the absence rate for (a) officers and (b) civilian staff in each year (expressed as a percentage).

2) Please provide details of how many of the absence days referred to in Q1 were attributed to mental ill-health or stress-related conditions.

a)If it is possible to do so within the limits of the FOI legislation, please also provide a breakdown of all the other reasons provided for these absences (for example, heart problems, broken bones, etc)."

In your email of the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016 you clarified your request to advise that you are seeking details on the number of non-uniformed Civil Servant staff within the Ministry of Defence Police only as well as MDP Officers.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

Please see 'Annex A' in regards to your request.

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, London SW1A 2HB (email <u>CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk</u>). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
