Herefordshire County Council (Addition of Footpath MF32 Mordiford) Modification Order 2010

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **1 December 2015**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the footpath which commences at the junction with Public Footpath Mordiford 5 (MF5) at Ordnance Survey grid reference SO 5816 3897 (point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a south-easterly direction for approximately 263 metres to Ordnance Survey grid reference 5833 3877, then in a southerly direction for approximately 27 metres to the trig point at Ordnance Survey grid reference SO 5833 3875. It continues generally in an east-south-east direction for 130 metres to the junction with Public Footpath Mordiford MF5 (MF5) at Ordnance Survey grid reference SO 5846 3873 (point B on the order plan). Section A – B has a total length of approximately 420 metres and a constant width of 2 metres.

As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 8 March 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.
