Statistical News Release: Police Workforce, England and Wales, 30 September 2015

The Home Office today published the latest National Statistics on the police workforce in England and Wales.

The release is a routine mid-year update of the annual Police Workforce, England and Wales publication. It contains statistics on the numbers of police officers, police staff, police community support officers (PCSOs), designated officers and special constables in post on 30 September 2015.
