Free school applications: Dalston Free Primary School, Richmond Bridge Free Primary School and Kilburn Free Primary School

I am delighted to inform you that the Secretary of State for Education has decided your applications to establish Dalston Free Primary School, Richmond Bridge Free Primary School and Kilburn Free Primary School should proceed to the next stage of the free schools process. This is a significant step towards opening your schools in September 2015. I would like to thank you and your colleagues for the commitment and energy that you have shown in developing your applications and at your interview.

I should point out that your approval may be subject to some very precise and strict conditions. Failure to meet these conditions will mean it is very unlikely that the Secretary of State will enter into a funding agreement with you and your schools will therefore not open. You will receive a letter from the lead assessor of your applications which will confirm what happens next, and this may include conditions as mentioned above. We will also inform the relevant local authorities and local MPs about your successful applications.
