Thank you for your e-mail of 24 February 2015 asking for information about military aircraft flying over St Eval in Cornwall.

You requested the following information:

"Please detail any RAF aircraft which were in the area of St Eval in Cornwall on the afternoon of 18 Feb 2015."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). We have completed a search of our paper and electronic records for the information requested and I can confirm that information within the scope of your request is held. The table below provides details of *all* military aircraft that passed within a 15 nautical miles radius of St Eval in Cornwall between 12:00 and 18:00 hours on 18 February 2015. The aircraft were a combination of RAF and Royal Navy aircraft.

6 x Hawk T1
1 x Hawk T2
1 x Voyager A330

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Deputy Chief Information Officer, 2nd Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information
