As discussed I have sought clarification of the 'successful completion of Conversion-to-Type (CTT) training' date which is the trigger for the commencement of RRP(F) for Army Qualified Service pilots.

From today, going forward, the completion of CTT is the end of course date. This means that start date for RRP(F) will be the final day of each course. This applies to courses that are ongoing now. This date is to be recorded in flying logbooks as the completion of CTT.

There is to be no retrospective action; those that have completed CTT before today are to continue to receive RRP(F) from the date that was advised to them by the respective course administrative staffs (ie FHT date in most cases).

Please pass this clarification on as appropriate.
