

We were asked:

- Q1. How much did you spend on your IT systems in 2013?
- Q2. What enterprise storage brands did you purchase in 2013?
- Q3. : How much did you spend on enterprise storage in 2013 and how many raw terabytes (TB) of capacity did you get?
- Q4. How much did you spend on open-source storage or Software-Defined-Storage in 2013 and how many raw terabytes (TB) of capacity did you get?
- Q5. How much data do you have stored digitally currently?

We replied:

- A1. You asked what storage brands are purchased and used by the Wales Office, and the storage capacity for our IT systems. The Wales Office uses IT services supplied under Ministry of Justice contracts, and we do not hold IT contracts in our own right. You may therefore wish to ask the Ministry of Justice about the storage brands and capacity they use.
