This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Secretary of State who has directed the authority to that effect that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of the Parish of Morley require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) and 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement, subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, and that the highway referred to in this order and shown on the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 28 May 2014.
- The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Derbyshire for the Parish of Morley shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
- 3. This order shall take effect on the date when it is confirmed and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Upgrading of Public Footpath No. 22 (part) to Bridleway and addition of a Bridleway from Almshouses Lane to Public Footpath No. 22 and from Public Footpath No. 22 to A608-Parish of Morley) Modification Order 2014.
