Financial Management	 Out of 78 returns, 67 [87%] (last week 64 [82%]) were submitted with data and 11 returns [14%] were not submitted that we have, at some time, received a submission from. This week we have not included in the analysis Trusts where we have no engagement since 31st December 2014. Additionally this week we received submissions from University Hospital Birmingham, Luton CCG and Mid Essex. We have not been able to include Mid Essex due to data quality issues.




