Thank you for your e-mail of 21 May 2016 asking for information about Expeditionary Air Wings.

You requested the following information:

"Are the following Expeditionary Air Wings still active: No 34 EAW, No 38 EAW, No 121 EAW, No 122 EAW, No 125 EAW, No 135 EAW "

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am writing to tell you that the MOD holds information on the subject you have requested.

Expeditionary Air Wings are by their nature temporary organisations. I can confirm that from your list Expeditionary Air Wings 34, 121 and 135 are held at readiness for contingent operations.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 2nd Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
