Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and transfer of an environmental permit to a new operator (the transferee).

The transfer of environmental permit EPR/ BJ7344IP from Aylesford Newsprint Services Limited (the transferor) to Aylesford Newsprint Limited (the transferee).

The permit is varied as a result of the requirements of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) 2010/75/EU are given force in England through the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 (the EPR) (as amended).

This variation notice refers to the operation of large combustion plant (LCP), as defined by articles 28 and 29 of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED). Environmental Permit EPR/BJ7344IP has been varied by the Environment Agency to facilitate the implementation of the special provisions for LCP given in the IED, by the 1 January 2016 (Article 82(3)). The IED makes special provisions for LCP under Chapter III.

This variation notice sets condition 2.1.2 into Environmental Permit EPR/BJ7344IP to ensure that the site can only operate in accord with Chapter III of the Industrial Emissions Directive. The Operator, Aylesford Newsprint Limited, must demonstrate their compliance with Chapter III of the Industrial Emissions Directive, should they wish to operate the site and must have obtained written approval from the Environment Agency before operating.

This introductory note also confirms the updated LCP numbers in accordance with the most recent DEFRA LCP reference numbers. The Combined Heat and Power (CHP) plant consists of a gas turbine (GT2), with an associated electrical generator and heat recovery steam generator (HRSG) and a back pressure steam turbine, an older gas turbine generator (GT1) is retained for occasional use under contract to the National Grid. Two back-up boilers are also used only when the CHP plant is unavailable with the LCP references changed as follows:

- LCP 98 is changed to LCP 9; and
- LCP 99 is changed to LCP 10.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.
