Email 5 dated 23 July from Defra to NFU:

I believe NFU heard yesterday on all of the emergency applications. I understand from colleagues that after discussion with the plant protection companies this was considered within the timescale which would allow the labelling and distribution of seed for use this season – although I am sure you would have preferred to get it earlier. I'm having a chat today with pesticides colleagues about the application processes and how to make it more user–friendly.
