A patient may opt out, or withdraw the decision to opt out of information that identifies them being shared outside of NHS Digital for purposes beyond direct care (known as Type 2 opt-outs).

This publication reports on the number of patient type 2 opt-outs as a percentage of patients registered at Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG) in England where patient opt-out information has been received from GP practices, as of October 2016.



Type 2 opt-out levels vary by CCG and over time. However 95.7 per cent of CCGs have between a 0 per cent and 5 per cent opt-out rate as of October 2016.
