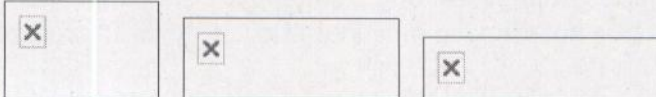

The game ingress is run by niantic labs which is part of Google. The only way I can see for you to contact them is via this link <https://support.google.com/ingress/contactflow?hl=en> the game spot also known as a portal is called "78 squadron memorial" and was submitted by player a grounded pilot who willingly brings people onto the base to "hack" this location.

I'm sure with the current state of this country's security threat level this is something I'm sure you will want to deal with urgently before someone gets shot for trespassing to access this location.
