STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN IMMIGRATION RULES

The Home Secretary has, with effect from 1 August 1997, made the change hereinafter stated in the rules laid down by him as to the practice to be followed in the administration of the Immigration Act 1971 for regulating entry into and the stay of persons in the United Kingdom and contained in the statement laid before Parliament on 23 May 1994 (HC 395), as amended. The amending statements were laid before, or presented to Parliament on 20 September 1994 (Cm 2663), 26 October 1995 (HC 797), 4 January 1996 (Cmnd 3073), 7 March 1996 (HC274), 2 April 1996 (HC 329), 30 August 1996 (Cmnd 3365), 31 October 1996 (HC 31), 27 February 1997 (HC 338), 29 May 1997 (Cmnd 3669) and 5 June 1997 (HC 26).

1. In the Appendix to HC 395 the word "Zaire" shall be deleted, and after "Cuba" there shall be inserted "Democratic Republic of the Congo (Zaire)" and after "Dominican Republic" there shall be inserted "Ecuador".
2. Paragraph 60(i) of HC 395 of 1994 shall not apply to any application for an extension of stay for the purpose of studying made by a national of Ecuador whose current leave to enter or remain was granted before 1 August 1997.
