- **A1.** Nil.
- A2. The Wales Office does not have any contracts with external companies to provide psychometric tests.
- **A3.** The Wales Office adopts the Good Practice advice provided by the British Psychological Society.
- A4. There are no specified levels of staff seniority that are given psychometric testing each year. It is not used routinely.
- **A5.** Psychometric testing is not used in isolation so will form part of the recruitment Feedback.
- A6. We did not use psychometrics in any recruitment exercises in 2014.
