

We were asked:

- Q1. A list of domain names (or URLs) that the department owns licences for, including the cost (in pounds sterling) the licence was bought for (if there is a yearly fee, please could you state what it is). Please could you provide exact dates for when the licence was purchased and the length of licence.
- Q2. Please could you provide a list for the past five calendar years, up to and including May 2014.
- Q3. Please could you provide a list of domain names that have gone before the GDS 'naming and approvals committee' that have been rejected or amended over the past five calendar years. Please could you detail the exact name of the domain that went before the committee for approval, the date it went before the committee and, if it was amended, what it was amended to. If any of the decisions were appealed, please could you provide details of the reason for the appeal and what the final decision was.

We replied:

- A1. The Wales Office can confirm that on 26 May 2010 it renewed the domain name of www.walesoffice.gov.uk for £100.00 + VAT. There is no further information. I also have no information on question 3. re. domain names that have gone before the GDS 'Naming and Approvals Committee'

The Wales Office transferred to www.gov.uk on 27 March 2013 and that is the only domain name it now has.
