Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Ince Marshes IBA Aggregate Facility operated by Ballast Phoenix Limited.

The permit number is EPR/TP3836FC

The surrender number is EPR/TP3836FC/S003

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state. The site is in pre-construction phase and no operations have commenced.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.
