

Amended and corrected tables from the Digest of United Kingdom Energy Statistics (DUKES) 2015

Following the release of the Digest of United Kingdom Energy Statistics (DUKES) 2015 on 30 July 2015, a couple of errors within the tables have been identified. These have been corrected on the DECC section of the GOV.UK website, in both Excel and PDF versions of the tables. The details of the tables that have been updated are as follows:

Electricity table 5.12: Plant installed capacity, by connection - United Kingdom

In the section, Distribution Network - Great Britain Installed capacity, of the table the renewables figures have been amended so as to exclude data for Northern Ireland.

In the section, Distribution Network – Total UK Installed capacity, of the table the renewables figures have been amended so as to exclude the double counting of data for Northern Ireland.

Renewables table 6.7: Renewable sources data used to indicate progress under the 2009 EU Renewable Energy Directive (measured using net calorific values)

In the first section, Electricity generation component, of the table in the row labelled 'Percentage of electricity from renewable sources' the 2012 and 2013 figures have been amended to 10.7%r and 13.8%r respectively.

In the fourth section, Overall directive target, of the table in the row labelled 'Air transport as a proportion of GFEC' the 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 figures have been amended to 8.01%r, 9.08%r, 8.54%r and 8.48%r respectively.

Renewables table 6.1.1: Renewable sources used to generate electricity and heat; electricity generated from renewable sources

In the section of the table labelled 'Electricity generated' the labelling of the Bioenergy data columns has been amended so that they read from left to right as landfill gas, sewage sludge digestion, energy from waste combustion, co-firing with fossil fuels, animal biomass, plant biomass, anaerobic digestion and total bioenergy.
