Request for Information

Thank you for your email dated 6 July 2015 requesting information on land transferred to the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA) or its predecessors in Corby. For ease of reference your request is below:

“Please can you outline any pieces of land including small trances, that were transferred to and therefore the safekeeping of the Homes and communities agency from any source including the new town corporation, English partnerships and the borough council within the Town of Corby Northamptonshire ideally on a map to show where the land is located.”

We have now had an opportunity to investigate your request and are writing to communicate our response. Attached to this letter is a spreadsheet which details all of the records of pieces of land that have transferred to the HCA in Corby and a map which displays the location of this land.

Please note that due to the historic nature of many of these transfers, our records are not complete and so the spreadsheet has some cells where the information is not known. Where the information is held we have provided the address of the land acquired, the other party in the transfer, the date of transfer and the size of the piece of land. It is also possible that there have been other historic acquisitions of land which have not been recorded on our systems.

There are two parcels of land detailed on the spreadsheet and map where the land is a reacquisition by the HCA. The 0.39ha of land in the reference number CB/TD304 is a reacquisition of land by the HCA. Secondly, the land in the reference number MK-SE/NNB/34 is a partial reacquisition, with 2.4585 of the 3.0213 being reacquired.
