PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about chimpanzee imports which we received on 8 July 2016. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

“Could you please provide me with chimpanzee UK import permit applications submitted to AHVLA (or any other government department dealing with animals imported to the UK from abroad) from October 28th 2015 to date in 2016 (imported to the UK for any purpose).”

In the period 28 October 2015 to 8 July 2016 (date of the request), APHA received 2 import application forms, covering 10 chimpanzees.

The first was for the same 8 chimpanzees in the applications that were sent to you in October. There were delays, so the licence was not issued until May this year. The application was resubmitted, which is attached at Appendix 1.

The second is for the import of 2 chimpanzees and again the application is attached at Appendix 2.

Some information has been redacted under Section 38, Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) of the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

Section 38 refers to the exemption from the duty to provide information regarding health and safety.

We recognise that there is a general presumption in favour of transparency and openness concerning our work, and providing the general public with the right to request access to information held by public authorities.

We also recognise that there is a public interest in disclosure of this specific information in order to increase this transparency and aid well-informed debates concerning the welfare and transportation of animals, and the individuals associated with them.

However, we feel that there is a stronger public interest in withholding the information as the full address of the premises of origin, destination, port of arrival and individual names would identify further information and would, or would be likely to, endanger the health and safety of staff. This poses a substantial risk to the health and safety of individuals associated with the transportation of animals that would be of significant severity and is likely to occur in some cases. We consider this to be a significant factor in favour of maintaining the exemption.

APHA has balanced the real threat to the health and safety of individuals which disclosure of the requested information would be likely to cause, against the public interest arguments in favour of disclosure. In this instance the APHA does not consider that disclosing the information requested in order to inform public debate and to promote accountability and transparency would justify the risk to individuals' health and safety.

Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) refers to other people's personal information. Section 40(2) and 40(3)(a)(i) of the FOIA provides that personal data relating to third parties is exempt information if disclosure would breach the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

APHA consider that disclosure of this information is likely to breach the first data protection principle in Schedule 1 of the DPA, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data, in two ways. First, disclosure would not constitute 'fair' processing of the personal data, second, disclosure would not satisfy any of the conditions for data processing set out in Schedule 2 to the DPA. Therefore, we have concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Information disclosed in response to this FOI request is releasable to the public. In keeping with the spirit and effect of the FOIs and the government's Transparency Agenda, this letter and the information disclosed to you may be placed on GOV.UK, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context. No information identifying you will be placed on the GOV.UK website.
