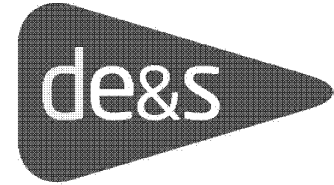

Thank you for your email of 24th February 2015 requesting the following information:

"I would like to know the amount of money in GBP paid to the University of the West of England (UWE) by the Atomic Weapons Establishment (AWE) between the start of the 2008/09 academic year and the end of the 2013/14 academic year.

I would also like to know how much money in GBP went the other way; i.e. how much did UWE give to the AWE during this same period?

I would appreciate it if the information could be provided in a spreadsheet format."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found enclosed. There were no payments after 3rd October 2012 and there was no money paid by the University of the West of England (UWE) to the Atomic Weapons Establishment (AWE) within the period you requested. In relation to the item at 25th March 2011 for -£132, this was a correction because AWE initially raised a purchase order for £924 on 4th August 2008; however, the amount invoiced by UWE was £792.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
