CHIROPODIST & PODIATRIST

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Chiropodists, also known as Podiatrists, diagnose and treat ailments, diseases and deformities of the foot and advise patients how to avoid a recurrence of foot problems. Chiropodists/Podiatrists carry out their work in the NHS, social services health centres, clinics, GP Surgeries and hospitals. Chiropodists/Podiatrists may also teach in educational institutions. The majority of Chiropodists in the private sector are self employed.

INDUSTRY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify as a Chiropodist/Podiatrist in the UK you must have a degree or diploma in Chiropody, Podiatry or Podiatric Medicine that has been approved by the Health Professionals Council (HPC).

REGISTRATION WITH A PROFESSIONAL BODY

The titles Chiropodist and Podiatrist are protected by law Anyone practing Chiropody or Podiatry in the UK must be registered with the PC. This register is on-line at http://www.hpc-uk.org/index.asp Only E. Nationals will be offered a period of adaptation training. Non EEA nationals must submit their qualifications to HPC international department to a ply for registration. For more information about HPC registration pleasures appendix 1.

CASEWORKER TREATMENT

If the Chiropodist/Podiatrist is IPC registered they meet the skills criteria. Applicants should provide a HPC registration number and caseworkers should check this against the HPC register.

This occupation is unsuitable for training.

where is HPC registered and the TWES criteria are met. The Society of Chropodists and Podiatrists felt that we should not receive many of these applications. An overseas national would already have to have a high level of knowledge to gain HPC registration. If caseworkers have any queries about these applications they should contact policy.

SALARY

The majority of NHS staff are now paid according to the new Agenda for Change program. All NHS staff salaries are based on a 37 ½ hour week. The pay bands for Chiropodists are-

Appendix 1

HPC registration

Registration with HPC can take between 6 weeks and a few months. To be eligible for HPC registration an individual who has been trained in the UK must have successfully completed a Degree or diploma course that has been approved by the HPC. The list of approved courses can be found on-line at http://www.hpc-

uk.org/aboutregistration/aboutregistration/educationandtraning/argovedcourses_ch/

If the Chiropodist / Podiatrist was trained overseas they must apply to the HPC international department who will assess whether the applicant's qualifications, work experience and thics are quivalent to UK standards. The HPC can suggest that a Chiropodist or Podiates un ertakes a test of competence if the applicant is already in UK. This can include an interview or clinical test and should only take a few or The HPC will not offer adaptation to any non EFA applicant.
