## PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about live animal export on 30 September 2014, which we received on 17 February 2016. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

“Under the FoI Act I would like to request information on a live animals shipment from Ramsgate for export to the continent 30th September, 2014.

The vehicles in question are with Trailer registrations:

OF 68 RN

OJ 40 PN

OF 39 DD

Please note APHA have no record of OF 39 DD on the date stated above. We do hold information on OD 39 DD, and the information is supplied.

Please can I have the following paperwork on the above trailers:

1. The Journey Log (WIT07)

Please see the Journey Logs (WIT07) for all vehicles at Appendices 1 to 4.

2. The Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Report (WIT32)

Please see the Vehicle/Livestock Inspection Reports (WIT32) for all vehicles at Appendices 5 to 7.

3. All Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHC)

Please see the Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHC) for all vehicles at Appendices 8 to 11.

4. Any WIT08 or WIT09 notices served  
No WIT08 or WIT09 notices were served.
5. If any animals were refused loading, the ET45 form.  
Please see the ET54 forms for vehicle BZ-HX-63/ OF-68-RN at Appendices 12-13.  
APHA do not hold an ET54 form for BZ-ZH-19/OJ-40-PN or BT-JD-75/ OD-39-DD.

Please could you also advise as to whether this vehicle received an inspection by Animal Health at Ramsgate Port?"

Yes, APHA inspected all three vehicles at Ramsgate Port. The Portal WIT32s are attached at Appendices 14 to 16.

Information has been redacted under Section 40(2) and Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 40(2) refers to other people's personal information. Some of the information contained within the requested document has been withheld under section 40(2) (third party personal data) of the FOIA as the information constitutes personal data relating to a third party. Section 40(2) of the FOIA provides that personal data relating to third parties is exempt information if disclosure would breach the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

APHA consider that disclosure of this information is likely to breach the first data protection principle in Schedule 1 of the DPA, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data, in two ways. First, disclosure would not constitute 'fair' processing of the personal data, second, disclosure would not satisfy any of the conditions for data processing set out in Schedule 2 to the DPA. Therefore, we have concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Section 38 refers to the exemption from the duty to provide information if it would, or would be likely to affect anyone's health or safety.

We recognise that there is a general presumption in favour of transparency and openness concerning our work, and providing the general public with the right to request access to information held by public authorities.

We also recognise that there is a public interest in disclosure of this specific information in order to increase this transparency and aid well-informed debates concerning the welfare and transportation of animals, and the individuals associated with them.

However, we feel that there is a stronger public interest in withholding the information as the full address of the premises of origin, destination and/or rest stops, transporter details and individual names would identify further information and would, or would be likely to, endanger the health and safety of staff. This poses a substantial risk to the health and safety of individuals associated with the transportation of animals that would be of significant severity and is likely to occur in some cases. We consider this to be a significant factor in favour of maintaining the exemption.

APHA has balanced the real threat to the health and safety of individuals which disclosure of the requested information would be likely to cause, against the public interest arguments in favour of disclosure. In this instance the APHA does not consider that disclosing the information requested in order to inform public debate and to promote accountability and transparency would justify the risk to individuals' health and safety.
