I appreciate your email. We are in a critical situation. Notice was given to terminate the agreement on 15th November 2014. We managed to get an appointment with Economic Youth Council at President's office on 12th November 2014. I am not sure whether the meeting is on or it will be cancelled at the last minute. They are not calling us (developer/investor - UK company) to hear our part of the problem. This is the first time, they are giving us the appointment.

We do understand we need to pursue the legal route. However I am sure there might be a role for UK Trade & Investment to facilitate and protect the interest of the British company which had invested time and money on this project for the past 10 years. Our colleagues from Netherlands and Denmark including China getting support from their Missions. We too expect the same. I am copying this email to our board member [REDACTED] who will be attending the meeting in Maldives on 12th November 2014. Also I am copying it to [REDACTED] to update the current situation of the project.
