users in the event that the EOL system becomes unavailable. In this event users will be required to submit their applications or journey logs by other means.

- e) By registering to use the EOL system, users undertake to take appropriate precautions to prevent the transmission of computer viruses etc. which may affect the operation of the EOL system.
