I make the following authorisation under section 19D(3)(a) the Race Relations Act 1976a:

PART I

GENERAL

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1. This authorisation may be cited as the Relations (maigration and Asylum) Authorisation 2001 and sharp come in operation on 2nd April 2001.
- 2. In this authorisation -

"claim for asylum" me struaim that it ould be contrary to the United Kingdom's obligations uper the Refugee Convention or under Article 3 of the Huran Rights Convention, for the claimant to be removed from, or required to leave, the United Kingdom;

"immigration laws" has the meaning given to it in the Immigration Act

"imm ration rules means the rules for the time being laid down under second 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971;

Refugee Convention" and "Human Rights Convention" have the reanings given to them in the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999d.

PART III

MISCELLANEOUS AUTHORISATIONS

Asylum Work Streaming

7. The Secretary of State may give priority to the consideration of claims for asylum from persons of a particular nationality or ethnic or national origin if there are significant number of claims for asylum from persons of that

nationality or ethnic or national origin which are unfounded or which raise similar issues in relation to the Refugee Convention or the Human Rights Convention.

Permission to work

- 8. Immigration officers and entry clearance officers may, otherwise than in accordance with immigration rules, grant leave to enter or entry clearant in a form which permits the holder to work in the United Kingdom to
 - (a) participants in the British Universities North America Consprogramme; and
 - (b) participants in the Japan: Youth Exchange Sclone; and
 - (c) British Dependent Territories citizens whose tatus ves from connection with St Helena or Tritan da Cunh

Translation of Documents

9. (1) This paragraph applies where a poon is to be gon formation relating to his application or entitlement to the formation or entitlement to the formation is averable in a mitted number of languages.

(2) If the information is not available in language which the person understands, it is not necessary to protect the information in a language which he does understand.
