Please state how many people have successfully gone through the New Deal programme over the last three years.

If you can include any course material given to those on New Deal detailing the course programme or different programmes available then please do attach this.

DWP response

Section 21 of the Act allows us to direct you to information which is already reasonably accessible to you.

Please note that employment programme policy is changing. Flexible New Deal (FND) was introduced in October 2009 in half of the Jobcentre Plus districts to replace the current New Deals for Young People, 25 Plus, 50 Plus, Employment Zone programmes and private sector leads. The new employment programme policy means FND will not be rolled out nationally, and will be phased out. The new Work Programme will replace FND and existing New Deal provision across the whole country in 2011.

The Department publishes a wide range of statistics on the New Deal programme on its website via the tabulation tool http://research.dwp.gov.uk/asd/asd1/tabtools/index.php?page=tabtool_nd. The tabulation tool allows you to construct tables to your own requirements.

For example you are able to use the tabulation tool to construct a table showing the number of participants for each New Deal scheme for the past thirteen months for which data is available. Earlier data is not published on the tabulation tool. Numbers of participants of the New Deal Programme at 2008, 2009 and 2010 are provided in the table below.
