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
Local Summary of Legionnaires' disease in Residents of England and Wales, 2014

Yorkshire and Humber

This report provides a short summary of Legionella activity in residents of Yorkshire and Humber, with particular emphasis on cases with onset of symptoms during 2014. Data for years 2012 and 2013 and in some tables and graphs, for years 2005 to 2013, are presented for comparative purposes.



Figure 3: Number of confirmed Legionnaires' disease cases in residents of Yorkshire and Humber by month and year of onset; 2012 – 2014


