



ESF Programme Summary – Skills Support for Young People in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly

Overview

The Skills Support for Young People in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly contract has a primary focus to support 16-18 year olds who are either undertaking an Apprenticeship or progressing to an Apprenticeship, and be either resident in, or work in Cornwall or the Isles of Scilly.

Within this group, the project will focus on three groups: young people undertaking an apprenticeship, young people in work without training, and volunteers. The support these groups will receive will vary following an initial assessment and may include additional units to core apprenticeship frameworks, unitised programmes as an introduction to an apprenticeship together with English and Maths where appropriate.

Throughout the programme, the provider will conduct a monthly progress review with the learner to monitor their progress as well as ensuring that the learner receives matrix accredited information, advice and guidance, to support facilitation to the next level. This dedicated support must not duplicate or conflict with activity funded through: an apprenticeship framework; mainstream Agency funding; the Education Funding Agency; the European Social Fund (ESF); Local Authority activity that contributes to the Raising of the Participation Age; Jobcentre Plus activity; or Discretionary Learner Support.
