Thank you for your email of 08 November 2016 requesting the following information:

- "1. What are the chances of promotion for an AB RN Chef to each rank up to and including WO1?.
- 2. What is the average length of service for an RN Chef on promotion to each rank from AB1 to WO1?."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm all the information in scope of your request is held.
