## PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER

## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

West Sussex County Council (Shermanbury)
Public Path (No.2384) Extinguishment Order 2014

This order is made by West Sussex County Council ('the authority') under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Horsham District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

## BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situate at Shermanbury and shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained within paragraph 1 of this order where immediately before the date on which the highway is stopped up in pursuance of this order there is apparatus on, over or under the highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 3. This Order shall not be confirmed until such time that the West Sussex County Council (Shermanbury) Public Path (No. 2382) (No 2) Diversion Order 2014 is confirmed
