Rationale

► RA 4063 relating to Replenishment of Liquid and Gaseous Oxygen Systems in Exceptional Circumstances has been withdrawn because the content does not require regulating as Continuing Airworthiness activity. Duty Holders are already required by DSA 01.1 and JSP 375² to identify potential hazards and implement measures to ensure the safety of personnel within their areas of responsibility; that is the more appropriate mechanism for regulating the subject activity. ◀
