At November 2011, there were 3,226,790 Disability Living Allowance (DLA) recipients in Great Britain of which 31,850 were aged 15. Please note that the figures do not include people with entitlement where the payment has been suspended.

In response to your specific question, the attached spreadsheet shows the number of DLA recipients aged 15 in the Parliamentary Constituencies that you have requested.
