"I request an up to date project directory of all companies, suppliers and sub-contractors involved in the Beacon Barracks, Beaconside, Stafford project.

The scheme – contract will cover detailed design and construction including; Demolition, construction of new buildings and changes to external appearance of existing buildings for storage, workshops, vehicle wash, maintenance, gymnasium, offices, training, mess facilities, single living accommodation, social and welfare facilities, extended fuel storage facilities, additional car parking provision, artificial surface sports pitch with floodlighting landscaping associated works."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).
