THE NEW HOMES BONUS SCHEME GRANT DETERMINATION (2015/16): 31/2574

The Minister of State for Housing and Planning ("the Minister") in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003 hereby makes the following determination:

Citation

- 1) This determination may be cited as the New Homes Bonus Scheme Grant Determination 2015/16.

Purpose of the grant

- 2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

- 3) The Minister determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in the Annex A to this determination.
- 4) The grant will be paid in four quarterly instalments.


Grant conditions

- 5) Pursuant to section 31(4) of the Local Government Act 2003, the Minister determines that the grant will be paid subject to the conditions in Annex B.

Treasury consent

- 6) Before making this determination, the Minister obtained the consent of the Treasury.

Annex B: GRANT CONDITIONS

1. In this Determination –

“authority” means a London borough council or the Common Council of the City of London in receipt of grant under this Determination;

“the Department” means the Department for Communities and Local Government;

“GLA” means the Greater London Authority;

“London Growth Deal” means the London Growth Deal dated 7th July 2014, agreed between the Government, the GLA and the London Enterprise Panel;

“pooled amount” means a cash amount, cash equivalent, or any combination of a cash amount or cash equivalent, equal to the amounts set out in Annex C to this determination.

USE OF GRANT

2. Before 1st October 2015 the authority shall agree, in writing, with the GLA how the pooled amount will be applied by the GLA in the area of the authority in helping to deliver the London Growth Deal.

3. The agreement under paragraph 2--

(a) may be an individual agreement between the GLA and the authority or a collective agreement between the GLA and two or more authorities;

(b) may include provision as to the minimum amount of cash that the pooled amount is to consist of; and

(c) shall take account of any representations made by the London Enterprise Panel.

4. The GLA and the authority may agree, in writing, how the pooled amount is to be applied by the authority pursuant to the agreement under paragraph 2, and the period within which it is to be applied.

5. The authority shall comply with any agreement under paragraph 4.

6. Where there is no agreement under paragraph 4, the authority shall, within 28 days of the date of the agreement under paragraph 2, transfer to the GLA the pooled amount for the purposes of applying it in the area of the authority in helping to deliver the London Growth Deal.

BREACH OF CONDITION

7. If an authority fails to comply with any of these conditions, the Secretary of State may reduce, suspend or withhold grant payments or require the repayment of the whole or any part of the grant monies paid, as may be determined by the Secretary of State and notified in writing to the authority. Such sum as has been notified will immediately become repayable to the Secretary of State who may set off the sum against any future amount due to the authority from the Government.
