Request for Information

Thank you for your email of 24 March 2015. You asked:

Please could you advise of the winning bidder and to what amount it was sold for under the Freedom of Information Act.

I can confirm that the winning bidder for the Shackleton Aircraft sited at RAF Mawgan was an organisation called Save our Shackleton and the price paid was £20,650.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
