Register of Business Interests

Entries should reflect the current position – that is the date on which you sign the declaration.

1. Remuneration directorships

Remunerated directorships should be declared in the case of public and private companies, detailing the name of the company and the nature of its business. Details of remuneration need not be disclosed.

2. Other remunerated employment, office, profession or other activity

When registering remunerated positions or employment, you should record the name of the company and the nature of the position or services for which you receive remuneration.

3. Significant shareholdings/interests in public or private companies

As a guide, shareholdings in an individual company which might give rise to conflict of interests or trust should be included where the market value of the shares exceeds £20,000.

4. Miscellaneous and unremunerated interests

This category is for the registration of any other interests not covered above which you consider may be relevant, for example unremunerated posts, honorary positions and other connections which might give rise to a conflict of interest or trust.

5. Disclosure of family members' interests

Family members' interests should be disclosed where they could potentially influence a person in the conduct of Departmental business, or influence the actions of other family members in the conduct of their business.
