## NO. 7 DECLARATION 2016

The land shown un-hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map A has already been declared a National Nature Reserve in The Lizard National Nature Reserve No.1 Declaration 1974, No. 2 Declaration 1977, No. 3 Declaration 1985, No. 4 Declaration 1990, No. 5 Declaration 1994 and No. 6 Declaration 2004. Natural England now wishes to extend this National Nature Reserve.

In pursuance of section 19(3) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare that the land having a total area of 1.54 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parish of Mullion in the County of Cornwall and shown crosshatched black on the attached map B (which land was included in The Lizard National Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration made by The Nature Conservancy Council on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November 1985) has ceased to be held and managed by Natural England as a nature reserve.

The land having a total area of 465.95 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parishes of Mullion, Landewednack, Grade-Ruan, and St. Keverne in the County of Cornwall and shown single hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map C is held by The National Trust and Cornwall Wildlife Trust, bodies approved by Natural England, and is being managed as a nature reserve.

Natural England is satisfied that the said land is of national importance.

And in pursuance of section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare the land referred to herein and more particularly shown on map C attached hereto a National Nature Reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as The Lizard National Nature Reserve No. 7 Declaration 2016.
