



ACF/CCF Leavers Converting to Services



Human Terrain Mapping Project



Overview

- Westminster Leavers
 - Total of 82k cadets left ACF/CCF between 1/7/2007 to 30/6/2010
 - Includes all reasons for leaving including 'Over age', 'Non attendance' and 'Disciplinary'
 - Some minor data quality issues but nothing that affects the outcome of the analysis
- JPA
 - Captures all service personnel from Army, RN and RAF as well as Adult Volunteers and Reservists
- SAS
 - Capability tool used within Army Headquarters and HQ Sp Comd to process large volumes of data from multiple data sources



Analysis

- Of the 82k cadet leavers, 5.4k can be matched to a JPA service personnel record
- Conversion rate for leavers in Years 1,2 & 3 across total cohort is 6.6%
 - 7.8% male cadets and 3.7% female cadets
 - 6.7% ACF and 6.0% CCF
- Average leaving age was 15.5 (143X was 17.9, 160X was 14.9)
- Following analysis to demonstrate conversion rates between Brigades, Cadet Unit Type, Gender, etc
