## **Information request**

- 1. The number of households in the following council districts: Southend-on-Sea, Rochford District, Basildon and Castle Point, receiving housing benefit and council tax benefit for each of the last three financial years, broken down by year.
- 2. For all of the information referenced in Question 1, I would like it to be broken down by local authority and into bands according to the combined sum of housing benefit received per year, i.e. more than £10k, more than £20k, more than £30k etc.

The information is based on the annualised value of weekly awards in a snapshot of the caseload on the second Thursday of February 2009, 2010 and 2011. Not all claimants will have received benefit for the whole year, and entitlements may vary from month to month, so this does not represent the total amounts actually received over the course of a year.
